2010 ANNUAL CONFERENCE Student / Teacher Travel Grant Application Form

Exploring Florida's Springs Coast: Its Springs, Lakes, Spring Runs & Bays Crystal River, Florida Plantation Inn June 14 - 17, 2010

Application Deadline: April 15, 2010

The Florida Lake Management Society (FLMS) will offer a limited number of conference travel grants to graduate students involved with water resource management studies, senior undergraduates working on senior projects, and middle or high school environmental science teachers. Travel grants can be used to pay for the attendee's conference registration and/or room accommodations at Plantation Inn on June 14-17, 2010.

For graduate students, we require a college or university contact (professor or other) to confirm student status. Applicants are required to submit their reasons why they would like to attend the conference, their expectations of what they will gain from the conference and their level of participation (session speaker, attendee) in the conference. If the grantee is part of a group of participants from the same college, or university and is able to share expenses, this also needs to be detailed and the applications submitted together if possible. Students will be required to sign-up for time slots to help with various tasks during the conference (e.g. registration table, audio-visual assistance during sessions...). Students are also encouraged to submit their research as an abstract for the speaker sessions or as a poster for the poster session.

Any graduate student, senior undergraduate student or middle / high school teacher who wishes to apply for a travel grant must fill out this application completely. The application must be signed and the hard copy mailed to the following address before the April 15th deadline to:
