

Dr. Erich Marzolf is the Director of the Division of Water and Land Resources with the St. Johns River Water Management District, where he oversees the Bureaus of Water Resources, Water Resource Information, and Land Resources. In this role he works on integrating aquatic and terrestrial restoration and management efforts to meet the District's core missions of water quality, water supply, flood protection and natural systems enhancement.
